Vendor Booth Rules

1. Booth Spaces are 10' x 10' for \$40. If additional spaces are needed, please let the Chamber know. All booths are required to stay open until 5:00 p.m. on October 5, 2019.
2. All booths must be registered no later than 5 p.m. on **Friday, September 27, 2019**
All booths will be assigned a space in the designated area.
3. Food booths must have an Environmental Department Food Permit, issued by the Environment Department Office, located at 708 Uranium Avenue Milan, N.M. If you have an annual permit, please disregard. Please call the E.D. office if you have any questions on this matter (505) 209-4042. The point of contact is Ramon. You can also receive a temporary food permit at www.nmenv.state.nm.us.
4. Electricity will be available for a fee of \$10.00 for each hook up. Please tell the Chamber if you will need a **110 or 220 volt**. Booths needing electricity will be assigned a space in only one designated area. If an electrical cord is needed, **IT MUST BE A HEAVY DUTY ONE THAT MEETS INSPECTION CODES.**
5. All vendors need to furnish their own trash receptacles, overhead coverings, tables, chairs, and extension cords to reach 100 feet. Use large trash barrels for your trash. Small trash barrels are for your customers. **You will be responsible for cleaning the area around your booth.**
6. **Booth set-up starts Friday, Oct. 6, 2019 at 4:00 p.m.**
7. **Sale of the following toys is prohibited:** stink bombs, silly string, fireworks, knives, or drug related paraphernalia. The sale of t-shirts with nudity, vulgar or drug related saying or symbols is also prohibited.
8. Absolutely **NO** amplification will be allowed, other than scheduled entertainment.
9. **DO NOT** remove tables and chairs from the area for personal use. If you are caught, you will be asked to leave the event.
10. The Chamber will have personnel in the area. **PLEASE CHECK IN TO RECEIVE SPACE ASSIGNMENT ON October 3, 2019.**
